JetBlue Announces San José/Boston Service to Start in May

SAN JOSÉ --- JetBlue Airways announced today that it will begin daily nonstop service between San José and Boston beginning May 13, 2010. JetBlue's new route will connect two of the nation's key technology centers with the only nonstop service between Silicon Valley and Boston.

"This is a natural combination that will greatly benefit our Silicon Valley businesses and residents," said Bill Sherry, Aviation Director for Mineta San José International Airport (SJC).

"With our comprehensive modernization program nearly completed at the airport, JetBlue's customers will enjoy a transformed terminal that makes travel more comfortable and efficient here."

JetBlue also provides service between San José and New York's Kennedy International Airport, and it now operates from SJC's recently renovated Terminal A.

"JetBlue is proud to continue offering more destinations to Bay State and Bay Area customers, and to be the only airline to offer Boston Logan travelers nonstop access to all three Bay Area airports," said Scott Laurence, JetBlue's vice president of route planning.
