### **Volaris to Launch León Service from Silicon Valley's Airport**

The twice-weekly flight operates on Saturday and Wednesday, with service from León arriving to SJC at 1:40 pm, and departing SJC to León at 3:10 pm.

A ribbon-cutting ceremony will inaugurate departing Volaris Flight #933 to León. The carrier will operate an Airbus A320 aircraft seating 179 passengers on this flight.
